The cabs feature seals to stop excess noise and enable the operators to perform at optimum levels. The operator enjoys maximum control thanks to the hydraulic systems to offer superior joystick maneuverability and clamp positioning precision while radial, parallel and combined operations are in effect. Arctic Package The Arctic Package is one of the many Special Feature Request that allows Dressta machines to perform at their maximum ability within difficult climate situations. Some of the popular Arctic Package components include fuel heating, cab heating, arctic cabs, oil heaters, an engine pre-heating system, additional lights for blizzard situations, push arms for dozers, ripper shanks, reinforced blades and steering levers that can accommodate heavier gloves. Application Customization Stockpile Dressta's crawler dozers have a stockpile compaction feature package that has been built to manage tricky job situations including sloped and unstable work environments. A reinforced Dressta steel drum is one of the main pieces of equipment for the SFR equipment complete with a winch line attachment consisting of brackets connecting to the drum. The line is prevented from touching the slope face thanks to the tensioning system. A precision line guide and cleaning system are in place.
